



Investigator Sponsored Research Program

Application Guidelines: Provide the Following Information

1. LOI Format

The type size for fonts measured in points (pts) must be no smaller than 12 pts. Use a white background, 8 ½ x 11 inches (21.5 x 28 cm), with margins of ¾ inches (1.75 cm) all around. Enter project title and investigator name at the top of each page and number pages consecutively. Graphs or illustrations may be included but will count towards the page limits. Any extra material will be removed. Submit documents as a single Portable Document Format (PDF) file and email to: info@imagingprobes.ca

2. LOI Project Information (1 page maximum)

- Conflict of Interest:
 - Do any of the researcher involved in this project stand to receive a potential personal financial gain (i.e. ownership of shares in an industry partner, consulting fees with industry partner, etc) from the results of the proposed research? (yes or no)
 - If yes, provide the names of the researcher(s) and relevant companies
 - Will any company benefit substantially if this application is awarded? If so, please identify the company.

3. LOI Introduction and Description (1 page maximum)

Provide background on molecular imaging probe or theranostic agent of interest and summarize existing data that demonstrates the promise of the agent for the specific clinical indication(s), how the agent will impact clinical decision making or patient management, what potentially competing agents exist and how the new agent would impact the market.

4. CPDC In-kind Services Required (1 page maximum)

Describe the development objectives to be undertaken over the period of the program with respect to CPDC services that may be offered in-kind. Where appropriate, CPDC will advise investigators that they must apply for parallel funding from at least one additional agency to help offset costs.

Describe any leveraged funding provided by commercial or institutional sources that may be applied to enhance the program objectives and scope (if any). Furthermore, briefly describe the nature of funding that lead up to the application to the CPDC ISRP.

Please note: The CPDC ISRP awards successful researches with in-kind services to complete the proposed program goals and does not provide awards in the form of operational funds. ISRP goals will be completed as a service within the CPDC labs and offices by CPDC staff.
